## **NOT YOUR EVERYDAY KIND OF ZEBRA**

Did you know that the Zebra Longwing Butterfly is Florida's state butterfly? Have you ever seen one? They are quite populated throughout



Florida and they're so pretty. They have one of the longest lifespans, living 5-6 months compared to most that live only a few weeks. They are quickly recognizable with their long narrow wings, which are striped black and pale yellow. Their coloring is a warning to predators that they are poisonous.

Females lay 5-15 yellow eggs exclusively on several species of Passion Flower plants. When caterpillars emerge within 3-5 days, they eat the passion plant and acquire some of their toxins, making them have an unpleasant taste and making them poisonous to predators. Nature is so cool!
