COVENANTS CORNER

Listed below are some of the Covenant rules that you received when purchasing your home in Lake 'n Golf Estates. The committee decided that a review of these rules is necessary because we have received comments and noticed ourselves that some of these rules have not been followed. If any of these rules pertain to you, we will be visiting you personally in February to address the issues.

- Lamp posts are to be maintained and lighted year round from dusk to dawn.
- Each owner shall keep their site neat, clean and properly maintained.
- Clotheslines must be located at the rear of the home. No drying of clothes on carports will be allowed.
- No storage of any kind will be permitted in the yard area of the home.
- Absolutely NO PETS shall be allowed or kept in the subdivision.
- No overnight parking on the streets at any time will be allowed.
- Guest under the age of 35 years of age are limited to 30 days per year.

The City of Winter Haven requires 3" address numbers on homes to identify in case of emergency (4" numbers are preferable).
