February 5, 1922 – Reader’s Digest is first published.




If you haven't already paid your 2024 HOA annual assessment, your household assessment of \$500.00 is due on February 1st.



WILD-ly Focused

We had a rare visitor in our community this past month, this handsome wood stork. We've had them visit before, but not very often. This friend was oddly traveling alone. Usually, wood storks travel in flocks and live in colonies.

Other than being a little odd looking, they are quite a fascinating bird. They are a large wading bird that hunts for fish or other fresh water treats by placing their bill open in the water, setting a trap.



Sometimes, they slowly use their feet to stir up the bottom. Then they wait. When they sense something by their bill, they "SNAP" it shut!

They have the fastest reflex in all the animal kingdom. They can snap their beak shut in a fraction of the time it takes a human to blink an eye!

When wood stork chicks are hatched, they actually have a fuzzy, feathery head. As they mature, they lose that and get that unique bald head. Bald is beautiful, right? They also can be very loud in the nest, needing to be fed up to 17 times a day! However, adult wood storks are basically mute. They communicate with hissing, grunting, and snapping of the beak. These young chicks will progressively lose their voice as they age their first year.

Lastly, adult wood storks will bring water into the nest and regurgitate it over the chicks to give them a shower while they preen and to keep them cool in the heat of the day. Not exactly a water park, huh?


Lake Region's Show


The next street dinner will be hosted by Westchester and Princeton on February 24. More information will be coming so save the date.
