#### **LAKE 'N GOLF - CRUISES**

Cruise 1: is a short one on December 2, 2019 through the 6<sup>th</sup>, going to Coco Cay and Nassau, Bahamas. Both cruises are being offered exclusively by Cook's Travel Center and on the longer cruise he offers E-Z pay after your deposit with no interest, making the cruise very affordable. Just make sure you mention my name and Lake 'n Golf. Both cruises are being sold along with another mobile home park and we want to make sure you are seated with our group. Recently, Polk County made a change and no longer accepts glass jars and bottles. This change does not affect us, City of Winter Haven customers. Per the City of Winter Haven Solid Waste Department, they are collecting glass jars and bottles. If the City makes a change to this policy, the City will notify us. The person I spoke with apologized for the drivers that removed glass items from recycling bins and leaving them on people's lawns. He stated that the City sometimes uses County drivers and apparently this is what the County drivers do when they find glass in recycling bins. So, bottom line is: we are to continue recycling glass jars and bottles until we are notified otherwise. If you find that glass is being removed from your bin, PLEASE contact the City at 863-291-5756 – they need to know about the problem to correct it.
